

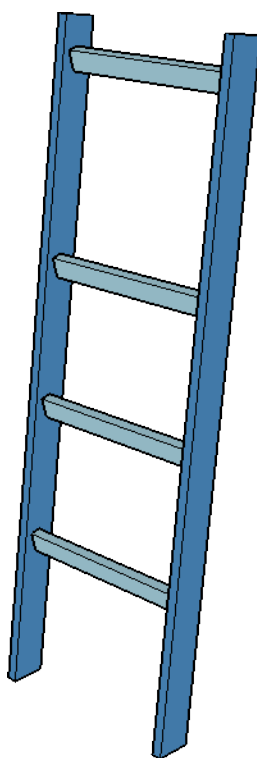
Nursery Storage Ladder

CUTS:

- 4 | 1x2 @ 14" (rungs)
- 2 | 1x3 @ 4' (legs)
* cut one side of each leg at a 5° angle so that it leans against the wall nicely

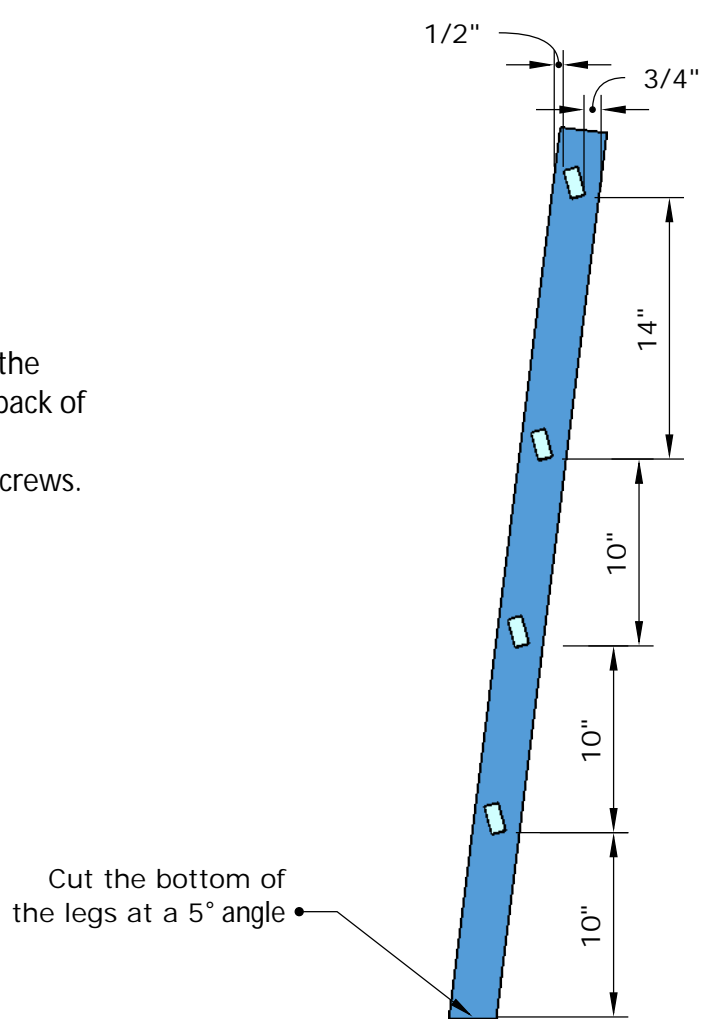
LUMBER:

- 1 | 1x2 - 6'
- 1 | 1x3 - 8'



STEP 1.

Attach 1x2 rungs to the ladder leg according to the measurements shown in the figure on the right. Angle the rungs so that the front corner is 1/2" from the front of the leg and the back corner is 3/4" from the back of the leg. Attach with wood glue and 1-1/4" pocket holes and screws.



STEP 2.

Make sure to face the pocket holes towards the back of the ladder. Attach the other 1x3 leg the same as the first leg. Sand and finish as desired.

Once the ladder dries, add 5/8" hooks to the bottom three ladder rungs and hang your baskets.
